IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Grill Area and Food

- Grill teams must supply their own grills at their homes or place of business. Gas, charcoal and smokers are all accepted. Please follow local fire restrictions and guidelines.
- Only 20 teams permitted. Please sign up early so we can make this event known throughout our community! **Registration deadline is Friday, May 28, 2021.**
- **Tasting Time TBD**
- Grill teams must supply their own food and may prepare any type of grilled item. A portion might be one rib, one wing, one ounce of beef, two shrimp or a few grilled vegetables.
- We encourage a variety of food items (beef, chicken, pork, lamb, veggies, fruits, etc.)

Fee, Theme/Decorations and Judging

- Each grill team will choose a team name and theme.
- Grill teams are encouraged to wear costumes and decorate their grill area related to their theme; advertising for your business is definitely permitted and encouraged.
- Prizes will be awarded in several categories including but not limited to:
 - Top Fundraiser
 - Best Theme/Décor
 - Best Cuisine
 - Best Meat
 - Most Creative
 - Best Use of Covid-19 Guidelines
- There will be traveling judges coming to where you are grilling to sample food and then later vote. If you are not comfortable with this, please let us know ASAP. You can still be a part of the event, Men Who Grill...AT HOME!

Other Rules

- **Please consider the most current Social Distancing Rules around gathering friends and family at your home, neighborhood, or place of business. We are not encouraging parties or gatherings larger than what Governor Polis and/or San Juan Basin Public Health is recommending at the time of the event. We also are encouraging teams to do a neighborhood event where people can drive-by or walk up and get a sample of your grilling delights and donate to the cause!**
